Construction for the Morton Grove Niles Water Commission Water Supply Improvement Project is Expected to Begin this Spring

The Morton Grove Niles Water Commission (MGNWC) is beginning construction on the Water Supply Improvement Project to develop a new water supply system which will provide residents of Morton Grove and Niles with a new water source, and the City of Evanston with additional water revenue.

As part of this project, construction and rehabilitation is required to install a transmission main to carry water from the City of Evanston through the Village of Skokie and ultimately to the Villages of Morton Grove and Niles.

Construction for this portion of the project in Evanston includes the construction of a new water pump station at 2525 Church St. and water transmission mains running under the North Shore Channel. The building located at 2525 Church St. (the former Shore School) must be free of all asbestos before it is demolished. **The work to remove asbestos will begin approximately May 14, 2018. The demolition of the building is expected to occur between May 25 and June 20, 2018.**

Once the site is clear, the construction of a new pump station will begin. The pump station will be located on the western portion of the existing building's footprint.



Construction and demolition will take place in defined areas as shown on the project area map on the reverse side. Work activity will typically occur Monday through Friday between 7:00 am – 5:30 pm. Occasional work may occur on Saturdays.

Construction traffic will only be allowed southbound on McDaniel by trucks exiting the site from the southern-most property entrance on McDaniel. No northbound traffic or staging will be allowed on McDaniel.

Pedestrian access to homes will remain open at all times. Parking will only be temporarily impacted when new gas and sewer connections are being installed along McDaniel. **Residents who are impacted will be notified 48 hours in advance of parking restrictions.**
