Citywide Asphalt Pavement Crack Sealing

Project Description

The City of Evanston will be completing asphalt pavement crack sealing at locations across the city beginning October 15. The work is expected to take two to three weeks to complete, weather permitting.

Drivers should expect short delays in specific work zones as flaggers route traffic around the work crews. **NO PARKING** restrictions will be short in duration and specific to each work area. The work in each location should take one to four hours to complete. Street sweeping of the debris typically occurs the day after the crack sealing is done.

This project will grind out sections of longitudinal and transverse cracks that have reflected through to the surface. Once the cracks are “routed” a fluid rubberized sealing material is injected back into the crack to seal it against water infiltration. This is an important step in preserving our pavement infrastructure. Street locations will be immediately ready for traffic once the process is complete.

The work is expected to seal cracks in asphalt pavement at 18 locations around the City. Please see the attached map for proposed crack sealing locations.

Contractor

The contractor for this project is Patriot Pavement Maintenance, 825 Segers Road, Des Plaines, IL 60016. The contractor is contractually responsible for the means and methods of the work.

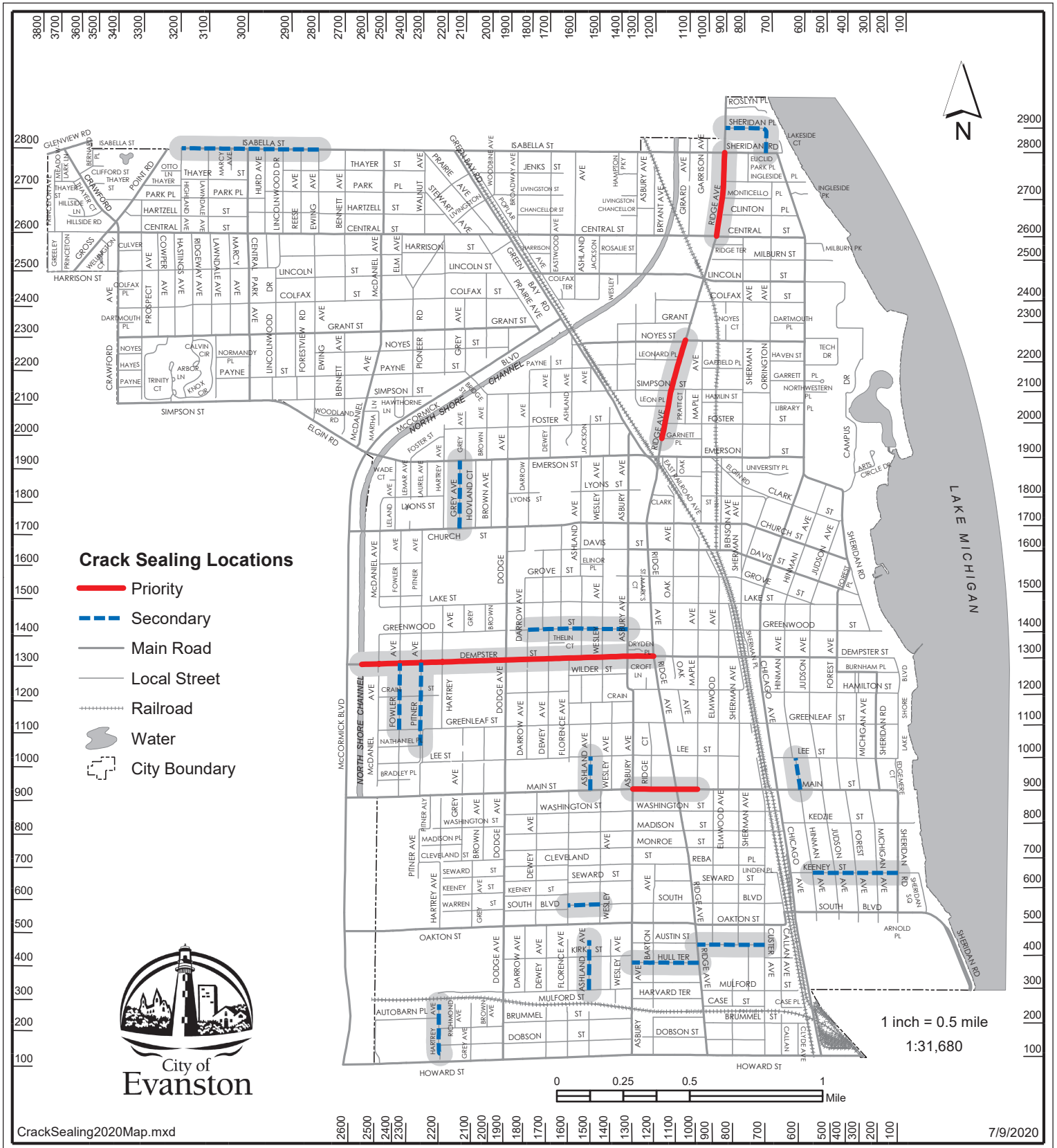
City Monitoring
