City of Evanston 2021 Alleys Improvements Project

September 20, 2021

Project Description

Over the next three months, alley improvements will be taking place at various locations throughout the City as shown below. This project consists of improvements to three alleys, a repair to the Civic Center parking lot, and installation of traffic calming speed humps on various streets and speed bumps in various alleys. The project locations are as follows:

Various Locations	Street Humps and Alley Bumps

Project Schedule

The project is anticipated to begin within the next two weeks. Work at each alley location is expected to last approximately five to six weeks. Vehicular access through the alley under construction, as well as access to garages and parking areas, will be prohibited once work begins. During this time residents will be required to use street parking; street cleaning restrictions will be waived for a one block radius. Refuse and recycling collection will occur on the street side of each property while the alleys are closed.

The exact date construction activities are scheduled to begin will be noted on barricades at the entrances to the alleys or on no parking signs adjacent to the work areas. Additionally, resident newsletters will be distributed to all affected residents. Every effort will be made to complete the work in a timely manner to minimize any inconveniences caused by the construction.
