James Park Athletic Lighting

Project Description

Over the next five months the City of Evanston will be contracting construction of new lighting at James Park. The project will provide athletic and security lighting for the existing soccer and baseball field east of the former Recycling Center as well as for the existing tennis courts. The athletic lighting will operate during programmed activities and reservations. The security lighting will operate nightly from dusk to dawn. An aerial view highlighting the area to receive these improvements is below:



Project Schedule

This project is anticipated to begin in **DECEMBER 2023** and be completed in **APRIL 2024**. Construction activities may create some inconveniences for adjacent residents but we will attempt to minimize these issues. Foundation installation will include the placement of steel pipe piles which may cause noise and vibration. To proactively mitigate these concerns, the construction contractor will install vibration monitoring equipment to evaluate and respond to any issues. Limited parking restrictions on adjacent roadways may be required to accommodate construction activities and will be signed with temporary "NO PARKING" signs posted 48 hours in advance.
