Main Street Corridor Project - Maple Avenue to Hinman Avenue

March 20, 2024

Project Description

The City of Evanston is starting the Main Street Corridor Improvement Project in first week of April 2024. This project includes roadway resurfacing/reconstruction, replacement of curb and gutter, streetscape improvements, street light replacement, traffic signal modernization, pavement markings and landscaping. The City is managing the project in coordination with the Illinois Department of Transportation since construction is partially funded by federal funds. The proposed Main Street project will significantly improve the business district aesthetics and increase safety for pedestrians while improving traffic flow and traffic safety. The improvement work is part of the city's continuous program to improve the roadway system throughout the community and is funded by federal and local funds.

This project will be completed in three phases. The locations of each phase and anticipated schedule is weather dependent which may vary few days in either way from the dates noted below:

Phase 1: Maple Avenue - Hinman Avenue – Sidewalk & Streetscape North Side
April 1, 2024 – End of June 2024

Phase 2: Maple Avenue - Hinman Avenue – Sidewalk & Streetscape South Side
June 17, 2024 – End of July 2024

Phase 3: Street Resurfacing - Maple Avenue - Hinman Avenue
July 29, 2024 to Mid-August
Grinding Main Street, Base Replacement as needed, Asphalt Binder, Structure Adjustment, Final Asphalt Surface Coarse & Pavement Markings

Street Lights, Traffic Signals & Signage will be completed by mid-September 2024.

During construction, one lane of traffic will be maintained on Main Street depending on the construction phase and access to the businesses will be maintained at all times. The actual date when construction is planned will be noted on the temporary **“NO PARKING”** signs posted 48 hours prior to the start of the work. The construction activities will create some inconveniences for the abutting businesses and residents, but workers will attempt to minimize these issues. Construction zone **“No Parking any time”** will be in effect on sections of Main Street in each construction phase. Street sweeping & residential parking restrictions will be waived for one block in each direction around Main Street from Maple Avenue to Hinman Avenue.
