Safe Routes to School Sidewalk and ADA Ramp Improvement Project

June 23, 2025

Project Description

Over the next eight weeks deteriorated sidewalk slabs will be replaced and some of the ADA ramps reconstructed on street blocks adjacent to the following schools: Oakton, Chute, Dawes, Lincoln, Park, Washington, Martin Luther King, Dewey, Kingsley, Lincolnwood, Orrington and Willard. The funding for the project is through the federal Safe Routes to School grant program and being constructed under the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) contract.

Project Schedule:

The work is expected to start the week of June 30, 2025 and be substantially completed by mid-August, 2025, weather permitting. Some existing sidewalks/crosswalks will be closed as needed until the work is completed. At areas where parking needs to be restricted for construction, No Parking, signs will be posted 48 hours prior to the start of work. Any irrigation sprinkler system in the parkway should be identified and marked with a flag by adjacent property owner prior to the start of construction to prevent damages to the private system.

Contractor

The contractor for this improvement project Triggi Construction, Inc., (1975 Powis Road, West Chicago, IL 60186). The contractor is contractually responsible for the means and methods of the work.
