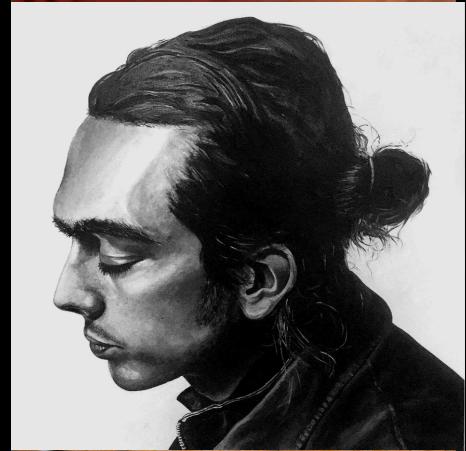

The **Bridge at 909** debuts as an exhibition program as the result of a partnership with the City of Evanston and Lincoln Property Company. It has the deliberate purpose of bringing together emerging artists and late career artists from different generations, backgrounds, and lived experiences.

Seen: Portraiture as Storytelling brings together portrait paintings by two artists, **Gabi Bozeman** and **Chris Froeter** to explore the same human question: what does it mean to be seen?

Portraits have always been more than just pictures of people. They hold emotion, memory, and choice. In this exhibition, faces become places where stories unfold. Sometimes those stories are offered openly through eye contact. Other times, they are shared more quietly through a turned head or a gaze that looks inward rather than out.
