City of Evanston 2026 MFT Street Resurfacing Project

June 1, 2026

Project Description

Over the next twelve weeks, the City of Evanston will be contracting road resurfacing work on seven street segments throughout the City. This project involves curb replacement as needed, roadway base repair, sewer work, replacement of asphalt surface from curb to curb along with selected ADA sidewalk replacement and driveway aprons. The funding for the project will be from the City’s Motor Fuel Tax (MFT) Funds and there will be no direct charge for the property owners on these streets. The construction has been planned in two phases and the specific locations included in each phase of construction are listed below.

Phase 1 Streets	Phase 2 Streets
Harrison Street (Gross Point Road to Crawford Avenue) Haven Street (Orrington Avenue to Sheridan Road) Jenks Street (Stewart Avenue to Prairie Avenue with one foot widening on each side of Jenks)	Custer Avenue (Monroe Street to Washington Street) Dobson Street (Barton Avenue to Ridge Avenue) Elmwood Avenue (Dempster Street to Greenwood Street) McDaniel Avenue (Dempster Street to Greenwood Street)

Construction on the phase 1 street segments will begin **the week of June 8** and is expected to be complete by mid-July. The entire project expected to be fully completed by **the End August** except the sodding. The actual date when construction is planned for your street will be noted on the temporary **NO PARKING** signs posted 48 hours prior to the start of work. The construction activities will create some inconvenience for abutting residents, but we will attempt to minimize these inconveniences. Construction zone daytime **NO PARKING** restrictions will be intermittent throughout the duration of the project; evening and nighttime parking (5:00pm to 7:00am) will always be available. Street sweeping and/or neighborhood parking restrictions will be waived for a one block radius around the construction zone when temporary daytime **NO PARKING** is in effect.

Contractor

The contractor for this street improvement project is Bigane Paving Co., 935 Chestnut Street, Chicago, IL 60005.

City Supervision

The project is under the supervision of the City’s **Capital Planning & Engineering Bureau**. The Resident Engineer in the field will be Nathan Savino who will be directly responsible for all aspects of the construction.
