# Purpose



 Implement a new countywide borderless paratransit service that will provide eligible users a transportation option to access all areas of Lake County for work, medical trips, groceries and more.

• Consolidate and streamline 40+ existing services into a single countywide paratransit service to be known as "Ride Lake County".

# What is Paratransit?



A shared and flexible on demand service that responds to rider requests for travel within a defined service area geared toward individuals with mobility limitations that prevent them from accessing scheduled bus service, and/or live outside an area served by scheduled bus service.

#### Beginnings

• ADA paratransit service that complements Pace's fixed-route bus services is implemented.

#### **LCCTSC**

 Formation of Lake County Coordinated Transportation
 Services Committee to guide paratransit coordination efforts in the county.

#### **Service Expansion**

- 2010: Ride Lake County West begins operating.
- 2012: Transportation Market Analysis evaluates existing demand response services and provided service improvement recommendations.
- 2016: Ride Lake County Central begins operating.

- #1 priority is to identify a lead agency to advance paratransit coordination and service improvements.

#### Working Group

 Working group tasked to identify the most appropriate lead agency for the Lake County region

# **Lead Agency Working Group**



- Created by the County Board in 2019
- Conducted seven meetings in 2019 and 2020
- Solicited feedback from Pace and Peer Counties

### Recommendation

Lake County Government serve as **Executive Sponsor** in a new countywide service model and on a new Ride Lake County Committee, to be made up of local funding sponsors and service providers that will be created and replace the Lake County Coordinated Transportation Services Committee (LCCTSC).


### MCRide Service Area\*

Over half of McHenry County is covered by MCRide!


- 9 Townships

\*A rider does not have to live in the service area — their trip has to begin and end somewhere in the eligible service area.












## **Ride Lake County Services**




# **New Service Benefits**

  - Central source of public transit service
  - Reduced overlapping/competing services
- Streamlined administrative functions

# **Proposed Service Parameters**



Hours of Operation: 6:00AM - 6:00PM

Days of Operation: Weekdays and Weekends

Holidays: No Service

Fare Structure: Distance Based

Base Rate: <u>First 5 Miles</u> <u>Each Add'tl Mile</u>


Senior (60+) \$3.00 \$0.50

Individual with a Disability \$3.00 \$0.50

Estimated Ridership: 59,000+/- annual trips

Estimated ridership provided by PACE. Service parameters would be evaluated over time and adjusted to meet demand in line with available revenues.

#### Potential Ride Lake County Service Area




# **Using the Service**



- Registration and Trip Booking will be handled by a single phone number. (Pace Call Center)
- Riders can book a trip anywhere within the service area if either the pickup or drop off location is within Lake County.
- Riders may make reservation as much as 7 days in advance or as little as 2 hours in advance; it is recommended to call at least 24 hours in advance.
- There are no limitations on trip purposes or the number of trips a rider can book.
