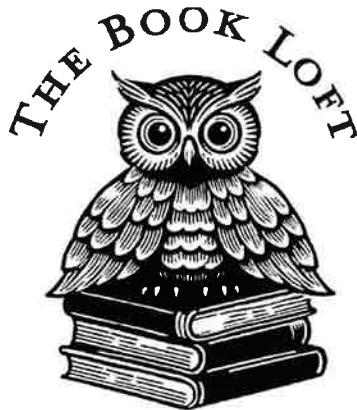

# EMBRACING CHANGE: OUR COMMITMENT TO THE NEXT ERA OF GROWTH

2025 has been a year of expansion and renewed purpose for the Oak Park-River Forest Chamber of Commerce. As the business community continued to evolve and navigate new challenges, so too did our organization - embracing change, strengthening our foundation, and positioning ourselves for the next era of growth and service.

This year marked the launch of major initiatives in partnership with our local municipalities. With the support of the Village of Oak Park, we introduced the First Friday Street Festival Series which activated four of Oak Park's diverse business districts, and Oak Park NEXT, a paid youth internship program connecting local employers with emerging workforce. Additionally, the Chamber collaborated with the Village of River Forest to pilot a Business Bash and networking event series. These programs represent significant new investments in community connection and business support across our Villages.

In October, the Chamber welcomed Yoo-Jin Hong as Interim Executive Director. Her steady leadership has ensured continuity across programs, services, and partnerships. Throughout the transition period, the Chamber's Board of Directors provided collaborative stewardship - reinforcing organizational stability and shared leadership during a pivotal year.

## HEALTH & WELLNESS FAIR

**More than 80 organizations • 500+ attendees**

The 9th Annual Health & Wellness Fair took place on Sunday, April 27 at the Park District of Oak Park's Community Recreation Center. This high-impact event featured more than 80 vendors from our membership's robust local healthcare providers and wellness services, and drew a strong turnout from the public, connecting attendees with community resources, support and solutions for overall well-being.

## FIRST FRIDAYS

**4 events • 83 businesses • 5000+ attendees**

This new street festival series was a rotating monthly celebration that activated four of Oak Park's diverse business districts with live entertainment, vendor participation, and community-driven activities, fostering neighborhood connections and supporting local economic growth. Events in the Chicago-Austin, Madison Street, Southtown and Pleasant districts featured 83 total vendors, music curated by Robert's Westside, and family fun while boosting visibility and foot traffic for local establishments. The series proved highly successful, generating powerful community impact and contributing meaningfully to Oak Park's economic vitality and cross-neighborhood cohesion.

Oak Park NEXT (Navigating Employment and eXperience Training): Youth Internship Program is a workforce development initiative created to support Oak Park businesses by connecting them with local youth residents aged 14-21 for paid, educational internships. The program serves as a vital resource for businesses experiencing staffing shortages while providing students with early career exposure, hands-on skills, and insight into potential career pathways within Oak Park.
