2025 has been a year of expansion and renewed purpose for the Oak Park-River Forest Chamber of Commerce. HEALTH & WELLNESS FAIR

More than 80 organizations • 500+ attendees

The 9th Annual Health & Wellness Fair took place on Sunday, April 27 at the Park District of Oak Park's Community Recreation Center. This high-impact event featured more than 80 vendors from our membership's robust local healthcare providers and wellness services, and drew a strong turnout from the public, connecting attendees with community resources, support and solutions for overall well-being.

This new street festival series was a rotating monthly celebration that activated four of Oak Park's diverse business districts with live entertainment, vendor participation, and community-driven activities, fostering neighborhood connections and supporting local economic growth. Events in the Chicago-Austin, Madison Street, Southtown and Pleasant districts featured 83 total vendors, music curated by Robert's Westside, and family fun while boosting visibility and foot traffic for local establishments. The series proved highly successful, generating powerful community impact and contributing meaningfully to Oak Park's economic vitality and cross-neighborhood cohesion.
