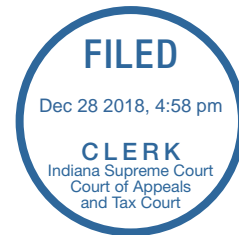

Order

[1] On October 12, 2018, this Court issued an order directing Appellants to show cause within thirty (30) days by filing evidence that appropriate payment arrangements had been made with the trial court reporter for preparation of the transcript.
