**TEMPORARY RESTRAINING
ORDER**

This matter was heard upon the State of Indiana's Verified Motion for Emergency Temporary Restraining Order. The Court now finds the acts sought to be enjoined are unlawful acts by the Defendant and, therefore, the State need not make a showing of irreparable harm or a balance of the hardships in its favor. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order shall expire ten (10) days from the date and time of its issuance unless the Court grants an extension for good
