DEFAULT JUDGMENT AGAINST DEFENDANT KEITH WILLIAMS

The Plaintiff, State of Indiana, having filed its Motion for Default Judgment and the Court having read the same and being duly advised in the premises, now finds:

- The Court has subject matter jurisdiction and personal jurisdiction over the Defendant, Keith Williams.
- The State provided Defendant Keith Williams with proper notice of these proceedings through service by certified mail at 2210 Churchman Avenue, Indianapolis, IN 46203.
- 3. Defendant Keith Williams failed to plead or otherwise respond in this action.
- 4. Defendant Keith Williams is not an infant, incompetent, or in the military service.

## RELIEF

- 5. IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED the Motion for Default

  Judgment is GRANTED in favor of the Plaintiff, State of Indiana, and against
  the Defendant, Keith Williams. Judgment is entered for the relief described in
  Paragraphs 6 through 8 of this Order.
- 6. Judgment is entered in favor of the Plaintiff and against Defendant Keith
  Williams for a permanent injunction under Ind. Code § 24-5-0.5-4(c)(1), enjoining
  him from:
  - 6.1. Advertising or selling a motor vehicle in Indiana, other than his personal vehicle titled in his own name, without obtaining a motor vehicle dealer license issued by the Indiana Secretary of State, unless Williams is selling vehicles as an agent or employee of a motor vehicle dealer with an active Indiana license and selling such vehicles solely from the licensed location.
  - 6.2. misrepresenting the mileage of a motor vehicle, either orally or in any written advertising, including any written advertising posted online;
  - 6.3. including a vehicle purchase price on a consumer bill of sale that does not reflect the amount of money actually paid or financed by the consumer for the purchase of the vehicle;
  - 6.4. committing an unfair, abusive, or deceptive act, omission, or practice in connection with a consumer transaction, in violation of Ind. Code § 24-5-0.5-3(a); and

- 6.5. representing that the subject of a consumer transaction has characteristics, uses, or benefits that it does not have, which Williams knows or reasonably should know it does not have, in violation of Ind. Code § 24-5-0.5-3(b)(1).
- 7. Judgment is entered in favor of the State and against Defendant Keith Williams for civil penalties under Ind. Code § 24-5-0.5-4(g), for Williams' knowing violations of Ind. Code § 24-5-0.5-3(a) and Ind. Code § 24-5-0.5-3(b)(1) in connection with his misrepresentations regarding the mileage on specific motor vehicles in three transactions, in the amount of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) per violation, for a penalty amount of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000.00), payable to the State of Indiana.
- 8. Judgment is entered in favor of the State and against Defendant Keith Williams for civil penalties under Ind. Code § 24-5-0.5-4(g), for Williams' knowing violations of Ind. Code § 24-5-0.5-10 in connection with his participation in numerous unlicensed vehicle sales, for a penalty amount of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000.00), payable to the State of Indiana.

A total monetary judgment in the amount of thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000.00) shall be entered in favor of the Plaintiff, State of Indiana, and against the Defendant, Keith Williams. Additionally, Defendant Keith Williams is enjoined from engaging in the conduct referenced in Paragraph 6, above.
