GUILTY PLEA AGREEMENT

The Defendant, MATTHEW WIGGINS, in person and by his attorney, George A. Streib, Jr., and the State of Indiana by Deputy Attorney General Maureen M. Devlin, hereby enter into this plea agreement made pursuant to negotiations.

1. This agreement, signed by the Defendant, Defense Counsel, and the attorney for the State of Indiana, shall be introduced into evidence by stipulation of all parties at the time of the guilty plea.

2. Defendant enters into this agreement knowing that the Court has the authority to accept or reject the agreement and understands that the Court may take the Defendant's criminal record into consideration in determining whether to accept or reject this plea agreement.

3. The Defendant agrees to plead **GUILTY** to:

Count 2: FORGERY, a Level 6 Felony

**Count 3: OBTAINING A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE BY
 FRAUD OR DECEIT, a Level 6 Felony**

**Count 15: OBTAINING A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE BY
 FRAUD OR DECEIT, a Level 6 Felony**

4. The State agrees to **dismiss** counts 1; 4-14; and 16-17.

5. At the time of the taking of the guilty plea and again at the time of the defendant's sentencing, the State reserves the right to question witnesses and comment on any evidence presented upon which the Court may rely to determine the sentence to be imposed; to present testimony or statements from the victim(s) or victim representative(s).

6. At the time this agreement is accepted by the Court, the following terms shall be binding upon the parties:

ALL COUNTS CONSECUTIVE

COUNT 2:

365 Days at Clark County Jail; credit for time served; remainder suspended to probation. CREDIT TIME TO APPLY TO COUNT 2 ONLY.

Defendant placed on reporting probation, with STANDARD CONDITIONS and the following SPECIAL AGREED TERMS:

SPECIAL AGREED TERMS:

- Defendant to be evaluated for substance abuse and comply with substance abuse treatment at a placement approved by Probation, with random drug testing for compliance. (MW)
- Defendant shall cooperate with any subsequent proceedings involving his Indiana Nursing License. (MW)
- Defendant agrees that he will not seek to practice nursing in Indiana or any other jurisdiction during the time of his sentence. (MW)
- Defendant to perform 40 hours of community service work at a location approved by Probation, but shall not be assigned to any placement at a medical facility or other placement with access to medication. (MW)

COUNT 3:

365 Days at Clark County Jail; suspended to probation.

Defendant placed on reporting probation, with STANDARD CONDITIONS and the following SPECIAL AGREED TERMS:

SPECIAL AGREED TERMS:

- Defendant to continue with substance abuse treatment if recommended. (MW)
- Defendant to submit to random drug screening for compliance. (MW)
- Defendant agrees that he will not seek to practice nursing in Indiana or any other jurisdiction during the time of his sentence. (MW)
- Defendant to perform 24 hours of community service work at a location approved by Probation, but shall not be assigned to any placement at a medical facility or other placement with access to medication. (MW)

COUNT 15:

365 Days at Clark County Jail; suspended to probation.
Defendant placed on reporting probation, with STANDARD CONDITIONS
and the following SPECIAL AGREED TERMS:

SPECIAL AGREED TERMS:

- Defendant to continue with substance abuse treatment if recommended. (MW)
- Defendant to submit to random drug screening for compliance. (MW)
- Defendant agrees that he will not seek to practice nursing in Indiana or any other jurisdiction during the time of his sentence. (MW)

TOTAL SENTENCE OF 3 YEARS.

JUDGMENT SHALL BE ENTERED AS A FELONY ON EACH COUNT.

7. Defendant shall pay Probation user fees, court imposed costs, and a fine of \$100.00.

8. If the defendant has not previously been fingerprinted, the defendant shall immediately after sentencing go to be fingerprinted at the Clark County Jail pursuant to IC 35-38-1-28.
