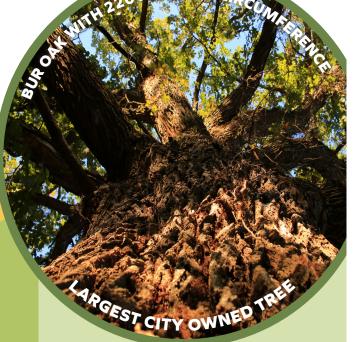
WINNERS ANNOUNCED MAY 6

IS YOUR TREE QUALIFIED?

- Must be on a private property
- Within City of Carmel corporate limits
- Permission must be obtained by property owner for Carmel Urban Forester to inspect tree
- Tree species unknown? Give your best guess!
- Past winners are not eligible
- Must exceed eligible species minimum circumference

HOW TO MEASURE

Measure near chest height at 4 feet 6 inches. At this height, measure around the tree trunk to get the circumference in inches.

- Sycamore, 272"
- Oak, 216"
- Maple, 216"
- Cottonwood, <u>185</u>"
- Hackberry, 165"
- Tulip Tree, 155"
- Elm, 151"

- Walnut/Hickory, 142"
- Honeylocust, 131"
 - Ash, 100"
 - Beech, 100"
 - Birch, 60"
 - Sweetgum, 60"
