
#### REPUBLIC SERVICES RESIDENTIAL TRASH AND RECYCLING - CART PLACEMENT FOR PICKUP



#### **IMPORTANT DOS**

DO leave your carts by the curb from 6 a.m. to 7 p.m.

DO bag ALL Waste. Unbagged materials are NOT accepted.

DO place all bagged waste inside the cart. Any bag laying outside the cart will require an "overage tag."

DO close your cart lid. Lid must be closed to prevent litter and keep vermin out.

#### **IMPORTANT DON'TS**

DON'T place your cart within 3 feet of anything else, including other carts.

DON'T put your cart on an uneven surface. Carts can tip over when empty or windy.

DON'T put wet paint or hot ashes in your cart. You are responsible for the damage.

DON'T overfill your cart. If the lid can't shut, the cart will not be serviced.

DON'T place your cart in a location where it might block your drive after being serviced.

DON'T park on the street on "trash day." Blocked carts will not be serviced.

# TIPS

to protect the plumbing in your home from freezing during extremely cold temperatures.



- If you have pipes along an outside wall allow a small trickle of water to run at night to keep the pipes from freezing. The cost of the extra water is low compared to a frozen pipe.
- Open cabinet doors to expose pipes along outside walls to warmer room temperatures.
- Insulate both hot and cold water pipes in an area that is likely to freeze since hot water pipes have a tendency to freeze first.
- Keep your garage door closed whenever possible during cold spells.
- Before the frost hits, make sure to drain and store garden hoses.
- Know where your main water shut-off valve is. If a pipe freezes or breaks, shut the water off immediately.



## LEAVING YOUR HOME TRAVELING DURING COLD WEATHER?

- Make arrangements with a friend or neighbor to periodically do a house check to make sure the heat is working.
- Never turn off the heat keep the thermostat at least 65 degrees. Anything lower than 50 degrees may cause frozen pipes.
- Turn down the temperature on your hot water heater to save energy but do not turn the unit off.
- Check your basement or crawl space sump pump. Inspecting the sump pump to ensure it's working correctly will save time and money.

(four feet or shorter bundles)
of landscape waste pick-up
per week, free of charge.

#### **CHRISTMAS TREE PICK-UP**

The city trash program includes pickup of one Christmas tree per home. Republic Services will collect the tree on the regular service day during the first two weeks of January.

- Trees must be cut in sections four feet or less.
   If the tree section is longer than four feet,
   it will not fit into the cage at the top of the truck.
- Cut all trees taller than four feet, in half.
- Remove all tree bags, ornaments, tinsel and stands.

Pick-up/Service Day will remain the same as normal.
