**SALT COMING SOON
AT CARMEL CITY CENTER**

Carmel, IN - Carmel City Center is excited to announce the upcoming opening of Salt, a local favorite known for its fresh seafood that is flown in daily, handmade pastas, and locally sourced steaks. The restaurant will be taking over the former Matt the Miller's Tavern location at Carmel City Center, marking its third location. Salt at Carmel City Center will open in June of this year and will offer a unique dining experience to the community with its fresh seasonal catches flown in daily and a variety of signature dishes.



Co-owner John Bales opened the first Salt location on Mass Ave in 2016, followed by Salt at Geist in 2023. Now, he's bringing the restaurant's casual yet refined coastal charm to Carmel. The menu will feature a wide range of crowd-pleasing items including Jumbo Lump Crab Cakes, Salt Sashimi Plate, Chilean Sea Bass, Lobster Mac and Cheese, and Filet Mignon topped with Maine Lobster Oscar. Salt at Carmel City Center will also offer an extensive wine and cocktail list, plus tempting desserts to round out the meal.

Salt at Carmel City Center will be open daily for lunch and dinner, offering a variety of quick and flavorful lunch options, including sandwiches, fish tacos, fresh salads, and sushi. In addition, the restaurant has collaborated with Gallery Pastry Shop founder Alison Keefer to create a seafood-inspired brunch on Fridays, Saturdays, and Sundays.

"We're excited to bring Salt to Carmel and introduce our fresh, coastal-inspired dining experience to this dynamic community," says Bales. "Our guests have embraced Salt in our other locations, and we look forward to sharing the same great food, hospitality, and inviting atmosphere with Carmel residents and visitors."

Carmel City Center is a one million square foot, \$300 million, mixed-use development located in the heart of Carmel, Indiana. A destination like no other in central Indiana, the project offers the appeal of a neighborhood and the vibrancy of a downtown. Carmel City Center features luxurious residences, specialty retail and restaurants and premier office space. Phase One includes 62,427 square feet of commercial space.

Charred and Salt will open soon. Pedcor is also in various stages of lease negotiations with other restaurant, retail and service concepts.

The apartment units in the Residences of Carmel City Center opened in summer 2010. The penthouse condominiums are all committed. Law firm Drewry Simmons Vornehm occupies 16,500 square feet of office space in Carmel City Center. Future phases of Carmel City Center include additional residential and commercial space.

Carmel City Center is the location for The Center for the Performing Arts, which includes a 1,600-seat world-class concert hall named “The Palladium,” a 500-seat theater named “The Tarkington” and a 200-seat black box theater. Carmel City Center’s boutique hotel, Hotel Carmichael, is now open as part of the Autograph Hotel Collection, Marriott’s independent lifestyle brand. Feinstein’s, Vivante French Eatery and Adagio Lounge are open in Hotel Carmichael. Carter Green in Carmel City Center is also home to the Carmel Farmers Market, Carmel Christkindlmarkt and The Ice. This pedestrian-based master plan development is located at the southwest corner of Range Line Road and City Center Drive (126th Street). The Monon Greenway runs directly through the project. Carmel City Center was developed as a public/private partnership between the City of Carmel, Pedcor City Center Development Company and numerous developers.

About The Nash

The Nash, a three-story, \$10 million mixed-use building, is just south of Phase I of City Center on the west side of Range Line Road. It contains 30 one, two and three bedroom apartments on the second and third floors and 8,000 square feet of commercial space at street level.

A.D.A Vintage, Be.You.tiful Nails, Forever Gallery, Graeter’s Ice Cream, Little Tulip Tree and The Shop are open.

About The United Fidelity Bank Building

The United Fidelity Bank buildings, formerly known as the Baldwin & Chambers buildings, a four-story, mixed-use building, is just south of Phase I of Carmel City Center and north of The Nash on the west side of Range Line Road. It contains 26 studio, one and two bedroom apartments on the third and fourth floors and 31,000 square feet of commercial space on street and plaza level. Addendum, The Cake Bake Shop, Lantz Collective, My Salon Suite, Oliver’s Twist and United Fidelity Bank are currently open. Pedcor is in various stages of lease negotiations with restaurant, retail and service concepts.

About the Holland & Playfair Buildings

The Holland & Playfair buildings, a five-story, 178,000 square foot, mixed-use building is located just west of the Veterans Way Garage and Hamilton West commercial space along the Monon Greenway. It contains 112 one, two- and three-bedroom apartment homes on the second through fifth floors and office space on the first floor.

Industrious is open and occupies 27,000 square feet on the first floor of the Holland & Playfair buildings.
