

Children's Commission Update

August 29, 2022

At its meeting last Wednesday, the Children's Commission voted to support the implementation of three evidence-based violence prevention and intervention program models in Indiana, and to seek opportunities to help fund such efforts. After an 18-month study, the Commission's juvenile violence subcommittee recommended endorsement of Cure Violence, Project BUILD, and Credible Messengers for Justice Involved Youth.

The Commission also approved its <u>annual report</u>, which details results from the most recent fiscal year in the areas of family & youth engagement, youth justice reform, youth mental health, and data sharing.
