### A NEW WAY TO TAKE ONLINE COURSES

# **Indiana Judicial Branch Education Network**

The Indiana Office of Court Services will soon begin a phased roll out of the **Indiana Judicial Branch Education Network**, replacing the Indiana Courts Education Network for hosting online learning. The new system will allow IOCS to better meet the on-demand educational needs of all audiences.

During the roll out, there will be a period in which ICEN courses will be inaccessible to specific user groups while transfering data to the new system. Notifications will be sent when accounts are deactivated in ICEN and once the new system is available. Following completion of the roll out, IOCS on-demand education content will be available on the Network.

#### Who has an account?

- All judicial officers should already have an account.
- Court and clerk personnel and community supervision staff may already have an account.
- All ICEN accounts and login credentials will be transferred to the Network.
- Any judicial officers, court or clerk personnel, or community supervision staff without an account may request one.



## What type of content is available?

- Courses include replays of live webinars, legal updates, jurisdiction-specific topics, procedural fairness, security, and health and wellness.
- Courses specifically designed for court and clerk personnel include new employee orientations, transcripts, security, and legal updates.
- Courses specifically designed for community supervision staff include completing orientation requirements.
