in 2017, the most recent year there is for national data; and

WHEREAS, abusive head trauma known as "shaken baby syndrome" is

recognized as the leading cause of death of physically abused

children; and

WHEREAS, most child abuse cases result from situations that are preventable

when community programs and systems are engaged and

supportive; and

WHEREAS, recognizing April as Child Abuse Prevention Month can be an

opportunity to help create strong communities to support

families and keep children safe;
