



DNR Interpretive Training Scholarship Application May 13-16, 2019 McCormick's Creek State Park

Indiana Master Naturalist Alumni are invited to apply for one of two scholarships to the Indiana DNR Interpretive Training held the second week of May each year. This is a very intensive, educating and hands-on training about the art of Interpretation. The Interpretive training *without* the Certified Interpretive Guide (CIG) component is \$230.00 (with CIG- the fee is \$380). Recipients will receive a 50% scholarship (\$115) without the CIG component or a 65% scholarship (\$247) with the CIG Training. Recipients will be chosen by the Indiana Master Naturalist (IMN) Advisory Council based on their answers to the four questions below. Applicants must supply the following information and be a certified member of the IMN program. The registration for the Interpretive Naturalist Training closes on May 3, 2018. You can register at any time, but the application for this scholarship needs to be in by **April 2nd**, 2019 to allow the IMN Advisory Council to evaluate applications.

- ___ \$230.00 Interpretive Training Workshop Only, No CIG (\$115 scholarship)
- ___ \$380.00 Interpretive Training Workshop plus CIG component, (\$247 scholarship)

Scholarship recipients are required to pay the remainder of their registration fees.
