

ILEARN individual student results will be reported within 12 days of testing* and final results will be delivered by [uly].* Online reports will include data that reveal strengths and weaknesses at the benchmark level for each class. school, and district. (*After Year 1 due to standard setting.)

5 Greater Accessibility Tools for Online Testing

Examples of additional supports provided for ILEARN include translations, glossaries, embedded dictionary/thesaurus, spell-check, rich-text tools, accessible calculators, intuitive graphing interfaces, and American Sign Language.

Educators determine how each standard should be measured (e.g., evidence statements, item types, cognitive complexity, etc.).
