# Working Together for Student Success

RE: High School Assessment Funding

The Indiana General Assembly enacted a <u>new biennial budget (HEA 1001)</u> for the State of Indiana in Spring 2019. This memo delineates the funds allocated for commonly used high school testing programs and provides a brief description of how those funds may be used. Specific guidance for each assessment will be provided at a later date.

#### **Preliminary SAT (PSAT/NMSQT) Testing**

The State of Indiana provides funding (up to \$1,900,000) for Grades 10 and 11 students of accredited public and nonpublic schools to participate in the PSAT assessment.

#### **Advanced Placement (AP) Testing**

The State of Indiana provides funding (up to \$5,200,000) for students of accredited public and nonpublic schools to take the College Board Advanced Placement (AP) Mathematics, English/Language Arts, and Science exams.

### International Baccalaureate (IB) Testing

The State of Indiana no longer provides funds to support International Baccalaureate (IB) testing.
