SPRING 2022 ILEARN SCORING OPPORTUNITY

WHAT IS THIS OPPORTUNITY?

In Spring 2021, 225 Indiana educators participated in ILEARN hand-scoring!

Indiana educators have been making an impact for the last few years. Recruitment was underway for 577 Indiana educators in Spring 2020 prior to the cancellation of Spring ILEARN testing due to the COVID-19 pandemic. In Spring 2019, 332 Indiana educators participated.

Many educators shared positive feedback about this process. It enabled them to learn more about the scoring process and obtain hands-on experience with items on the ILEARN assessment.

Cambium Assessment, Incorporated (CAI) and Measurement Incorporated (MI) are recruiting Indiana educators to be involved in the scoring process for the upcoming ILEARN **Spring 2022**.

WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS?

- Currently employed as an educator at an accredited Indiana school
- Currently licensed by State of Indiana (e.g., instructional, administrative, school services)
- Access to a computer/online device that meets the minimum technical requirements, high-speed internet access, and a secure work area
- Demonstrate ability to apply scoring criteria as directed and maintain consistent and reliable scoring throughout the project
- Willing to engage in a repetitive task situation and maintain confidentiality

WHAT IS THE REQUIRED COMMITMENT AND PAY RATE?

April 18 – May 25, 2022

Work Hours and Commitment:

- Teachers
 - Evening Shifts
 - 6 p.m. - 10 p.m. ET
 - 6 p.m. - 10 p.m. CST
 - Required Commitment:
 - Three nights per week for three weeks
 - \$20.00 hourly rate
- Instructional Coaches
 - Day Shift
 - 8:30 a.m. - 4:15 p.m. ET
 - 8:30 a.m. - 4:15 p.m. CST
 - Required Commitment:
 - Three to four total days
 - \$20.00 hourly rate
