

IDOE Office of Student Pathways & the Indiana Housing and Community Development Authority (IHCDA) are partnering to provide support to our Homeless student population across the state. This innovative partnership will continue the mission to end homelessness by providing navigators to each region across the state who will provide support and resources necessary for the continuation and delivery of services to our homeless community.

Navigators will provide systems mapping and navigation support to students and families identified as McKinney-Vento eligible by local education agencies (LEAs). They will collaborate with district level McKinney-Vento liaisons to assist eligible students and families with accessing school-based and community-based services, as well as explore and retain wrap-around services in each region.
