

VIDEO CONTEST

The Get ShakIN' video contest gives school-aged Hoosiers (K–12) the chance to win their class or group a Raspberry Shake® RS3D seismograph for a year to track seismic activity around the world! Groups can enter by submitting a student-produced video focused on earthquake preparedness and/or safety. A panel of judges from IDHS will select the Top 10 videos to win a seismograph, and an overall winner will be selected to receive a seismograph plus the grand prize: a visit from the Quake Cottage earthquake simulator!

CONTEST RULES

DURATION & ELIGIBILITY

The contest opens Feb. 1, 2023, and ends at 4:30 p.m. ET on Aug. 31, 2023. It is open to classes or groups of students in grades K-12 from public, charter and private schools that are eligible for federal funding.

HOW TO ENTER

Create an earthquake safety video, upload it to YouTube and complete the contest entry form online at https://on.in.gov/get-shakin-entry-form.

WINNER SELECTION

All video entries will be watched by a panel from the Indiana Department of Homeland Security. The panel will select the Top 10 videos based on following the rules, quality of safety information provided and creativity. Winners will receive a seismograph*. Grand prize includes visit by earthquake simulator.

RULES

- Video must focus on earthquake safety and/or preparedness, including a minimum of three different tips.
- Video must feature students and primarily be produced by them (adults may help with production).
- Video must be at least 90 seconds long (maximum three minutes).
- Video must be made publicly available online.
- Anyone under age 18 must have permission to appear in the video and promotional photos/videos related to the contest.
- One entry per class or group, but more than one entry per school is allowed.
- Be creative!
