IREAD-3 Spring 2023 Test Results Timeline



Immediately Following Testing: Individual student results are available within the Centralized Reporting System (CRS) within 24 hours of test completion. Schools may share these results with families and teachers immediately. Letters to families for <u>grade two</u> and <u>grade three</u> students are also available on the <u>Indiana Assessment Portal</u>.



Friday, April 21: All quality checks and discrepancy resolutions will be complete for the IREAD-3 Spring 2023 administration. This review addresses potential data cleanup situations (e.g., paper test book returned without a label, late invalidations). All scores will be finalized by this date.



August: Public release of official IREAD-3 pass percentages for the 2022-2023 school year occurs. The Indiana Department of Education (IDOE) includes scores for students who passed IREAD-3 during the summer retest in pass percentage calculations.

Pass Percentage Calculations

This diagram visualizes how IDOE calculates IREAD-3 pass percentages, which is not completed until after the summer retest administration. Schools may calculate their own pass percentages using data from CRS, but should not publish self-calculated pass rates to the public or media. IDOE calculates pass percentages outside of CRS using additional data, as defined in the visual. Pass percentage rates are not included in state or federal accountability calculations.

Number of Pass Grade three students enrolled in the corporation during the spring 2023 test window who pass the assessment in spring OR summer test administration*

Total Population

All grade three students eligible to take IREAD-3 in the spring window.

This includes students who received a Good Cause Exemption following either test window; students who received an "Undetermined" or "Invalidated" score; students enrolled in grade three during spring 2023 testing who did not participate in the spring or summer windows.

Excluded from Calculation:

Grade four or five retesters

Students in grade three with significant cognitive disabilities (alternate testers)

Students not enrolled in school/corporation in grade three during the spring assessment window

^{*}Passing score results from both the spring and summer administrations are included with the school where the student was enrolled during the spring administration.
