PARTNERSHIP BUILDING CHECKLIST



Staff can utilize this checklist to begin identifying the community resource needs within their school and corporation. This is not a comprehensive list, but may be used as a suggested starting point.

STEPS TO INITIATE COMMUNITY PARTNER ENGAGEMENT

Identify key staff to lead the initiative and serve as a point of contact for community partner communication.		
Interview or survey school staff, families, and community members to determine the areas in need of communit assistance within a school. The following are examples of community needs to consider:

- is feasible for the school to manage and consider if there is a need to outsource additional needs.
- Research and develop a list of community organizations and businesses that would be good potential partners for supporting with the identified top community priorities. Contact these organizations.
- Research and contact nearby businesses and universities to partner with. Collaborate on providing students with opportunities to apply skills they have learned in class through a real-world experience (e.g. internships, shadow day, career day, lunch-and-learn). This could initiate long-term community partnerships.
