

## ILEARN Biology End-of-Course Assessment (ECA)

## **Test Window Checklist**

Corporation Test Coordinators (CTCs) and School Test Coordinators (STCs) must ensure that the following tasks are completed prior to participating in the operational assessment for the 2023-2024 school year.

CTCs must complete the High School Pretest Workshop within the <u>Moodle Test Coordinator Corner</u> by Friday, January 26.
Review internal course enrollment data to identify which students should participate in the ILEARN Biology ECA. Review the <u>participation guidance</u> for more information.
Confirm that appropriate accommodations and designated features are correct in the Test Information Distribution Engine (TIDE). Refer to the <u>TIDE User Guide</u> and <u>Accessibility and Accommodations Information for Statewide Assessments</u> for assistance.
Review <u>changes to the ILEARN Biology ECA</u> for the 2023-2024 school year ( <u>Test Blueprints</u>   <u>Item Specifications</u> ).
Conduct and complete all required training, including annual <u>Test Security and Integrity Training</u> for CTCs, STCs, and all school staff. Ensure staff have signed the <u>agreement</u> and reviewed the <u>Indiana Assessments Policy Manual</u> .
Develop a testing schedule that adheres to scheduling and timing guidance; notify students, teachers, and families of scheduled testing.
Review and distribute the <u>ILEARN Test Administrator's Manual (TAM)</u> to relevant staff.
Ensure all Test Administrators (TAs) have completed the annual <u>TA Certification Course</u> and completed accommodations training, as needed.
TAs must administer the practice test to students at least once prior to operational testing. Practice tests are administered via the <u>Test Delivery System (TDS)</u> using the practice test script ( <u>English</u>   <u>Spanish</u> ).
Review and confirm that all deadlines/requirements found in the <u>ILEARN Milestones resource</u> have been completed by school or corporation staff.
Confirm that testing technology is up-to-date and meets policy expectations using Cambium Assessment, Inc.'s (CAI's) <u>Technology Guide</u> and <u>Assistive Technology Manual</u> . Schools completing testing on new devices may complete the optional System's Peadiness Test (SPT) as well





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
