Employability: Through soft skills training, young adults gain a competitive edge in the job market, positioning themselves for career advancement and success.

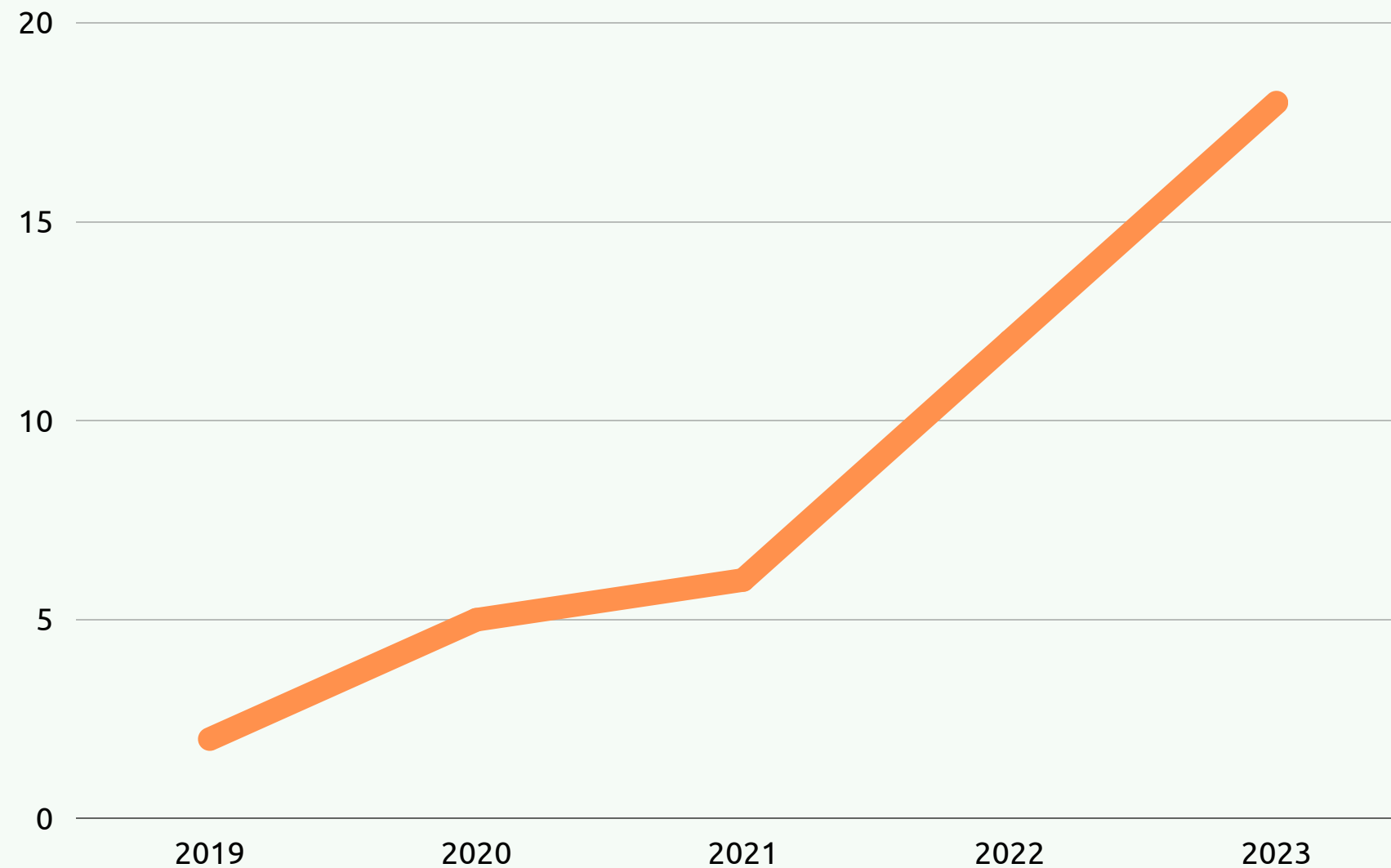
