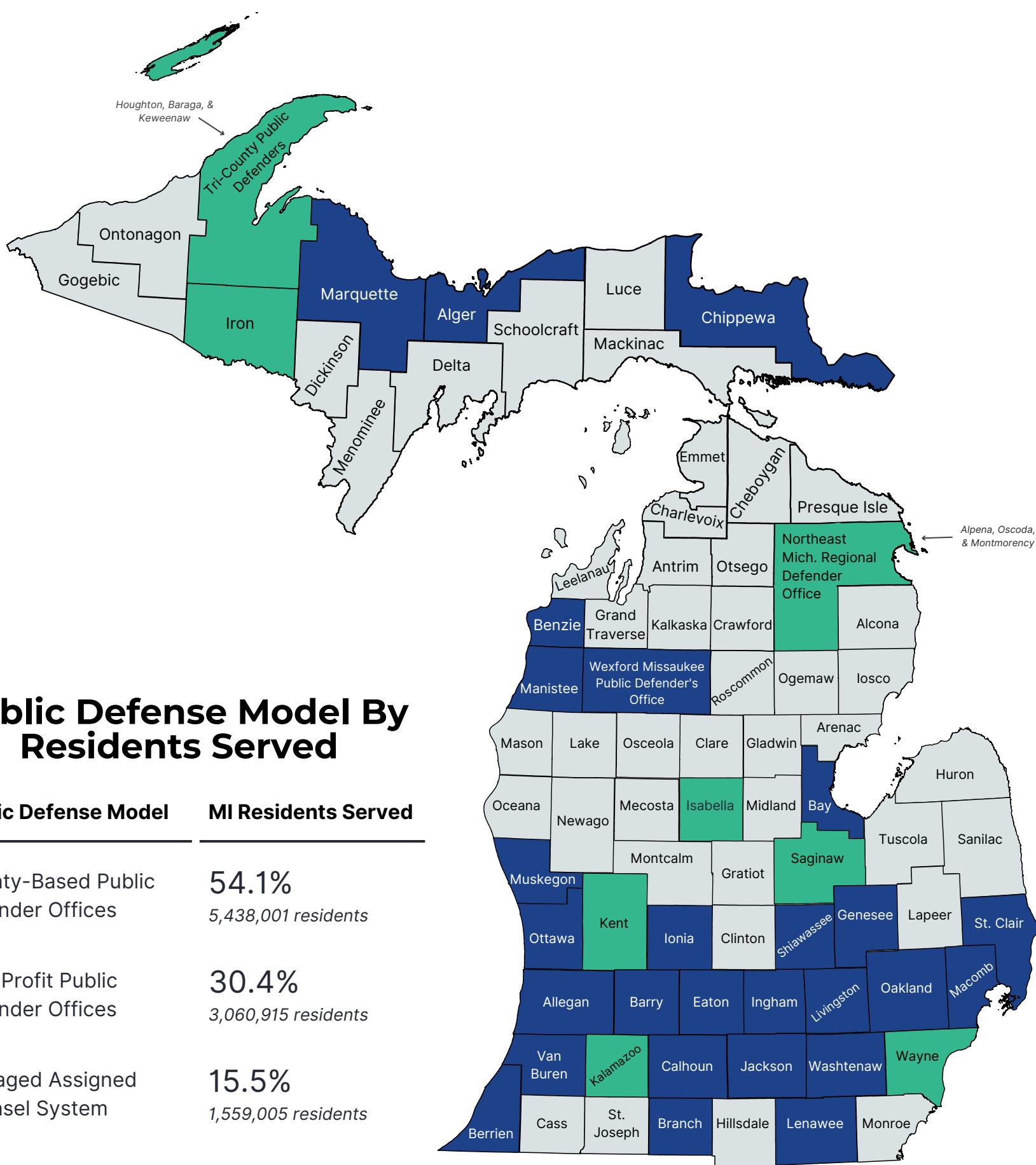


County-Based: The PD office is a part of county government and attorneys are employed directly by the county.

Non-Profit: The PD office is a 501c3 non-profit corporation and must contract with a county or funding unit to provide services.

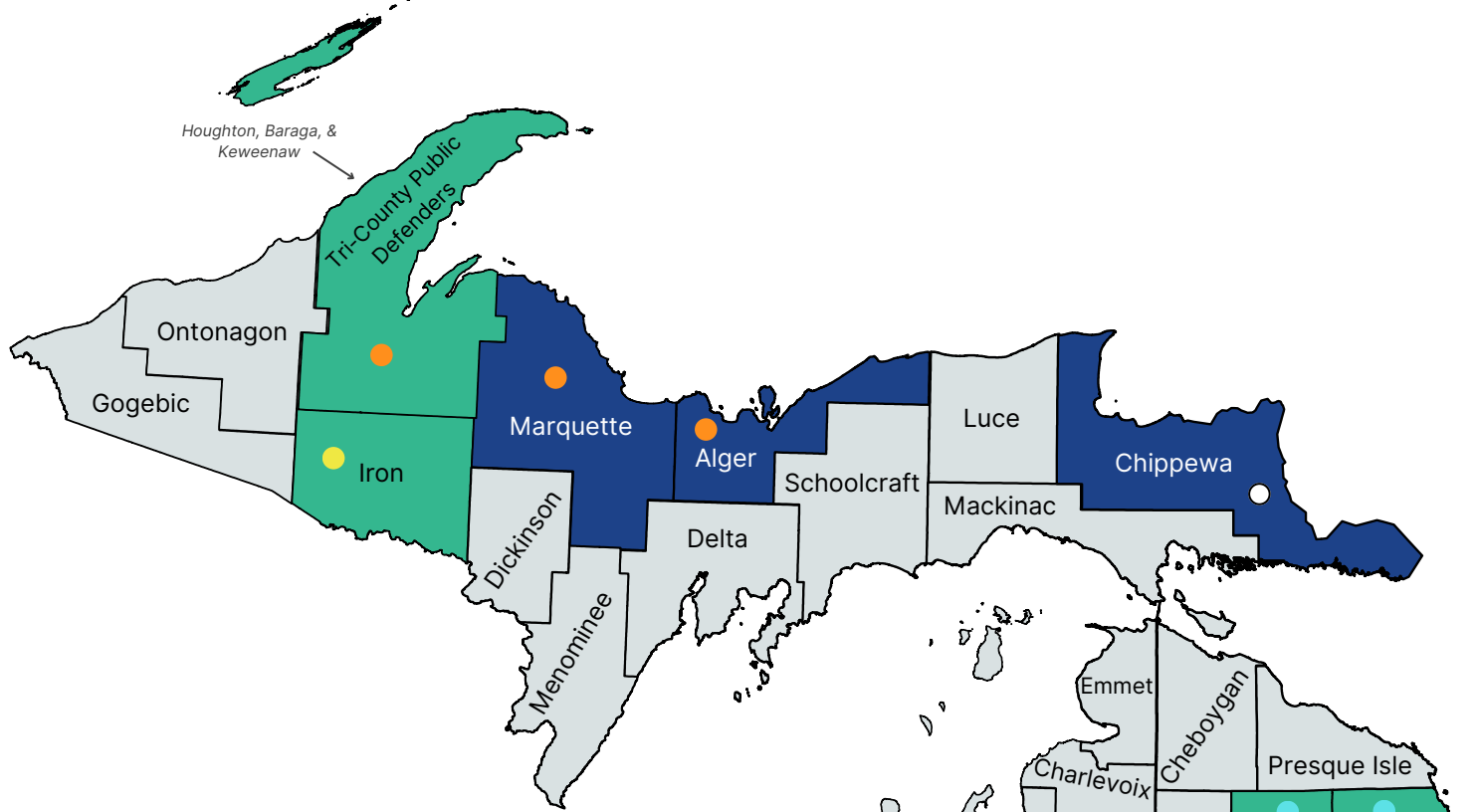
Managed Assigned Counsel: These systems involve contractual agreements with lists of private attorneys who operate separately from the county.

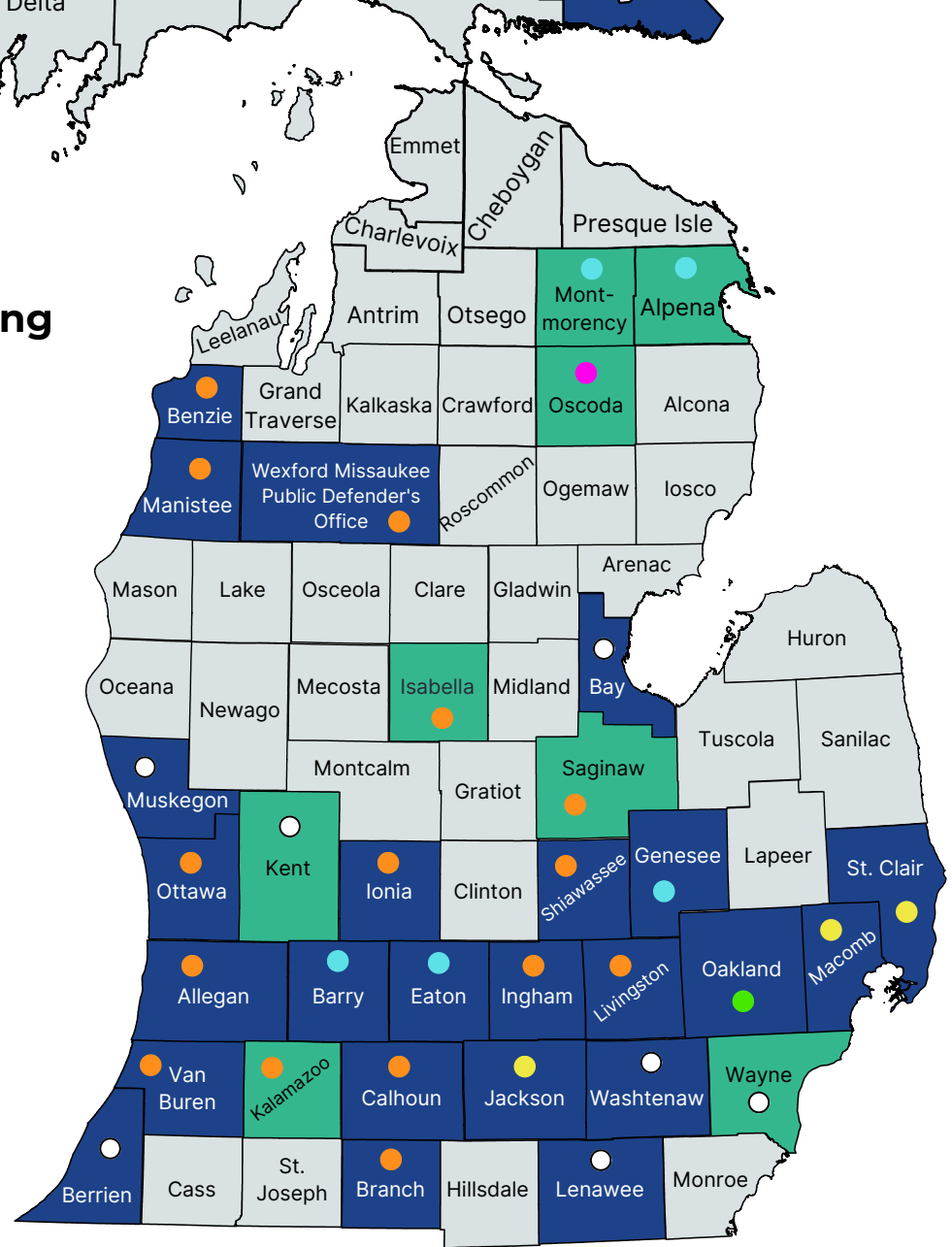
