## *About Maria Smith*

After 15 years in the banking industry, Maria Smith began her career at Harbor House as a part-time Executive Director in 1997. In the following years she developed and implemented operational plans resulting in a growth from an annual \$82K budget to over 1M. She pioneered and instituted its bulk-mailing service for participants, now generating annual revenue of over \$300K. Maria oversaw the planning, development and execution of construction of its 8300 sq ft facility that opened its doors in July 2003, enabling an increase from 20 to 200+ participants and a staff of 25+. Under Maria's direction, Harbor House has achieved top certification review award from KY Dept. of Mental Retardation - Only 13 out of 150 agencies statewide received this accomplishment.

Harbor House of Louisville is a 501(c)(3) charity that seeks to empower individuals with disabilities and their families to lead fulfilled and productive lives.
