### New \$1.3 Million Dollar Grant from Department of Labor will Expand Opportunities for Court-Involved Youth

Mayor Fischer and Congressman John Yarmuth announced the expansion of the city's Reimage program, which helps teens and young adults involved in the court system break the cycle of crime and hopelessness by getting jobs and finishing school. A new \$1.3M grant from the U.S. Department of Labor will provide training and job placement for court-involved young people ages 18-24. More than 440 youth have already enrolled in Reimage since it began in late 2015, and now the program will be able to help even more youth with its resources.
