

District 10 Discounted Recycle Carts

The discounted residential recycle cart program has been reinstituted. The 95-gallon recycling carts and 64-gallon recycling carts are \$28 **(this includes the now-mandatory 6% sales tax on the regular purchase price of \$50)** if you order through District 10. These are available to those in the Urban Services District (the old City of Louisville) that have Metro solid waste service. Make checks payable to Louisville Metro (no cash) and mail to Councilman Mulvihill, District 10, 601 W. Jefferson Street, Louisville, KY 40202. Please allow up to four weeks for delivery. No business, apartment complexes or residential buildings with eight or more units are eligible.

About recycling

Louisville Metro uses single stream recycling, a method that does not require different materials to be sorted into different bins. We have also made it simple to know what can be placed in your bin or cart.



What's permitted:

- Plastic (#1 through #7), clear food packaging and containers, glass, aluminum and steel containers
 - Drain liquids from all containers before placing them in your bin or cart
- Paper and cardboard (anything that tears)
 - Flatten what you can to save space
 - Collect loose papers in a paper bag or place at the bottom of the bin or cart
- You may set out as many bins as needed

What's not permitted:

- No window glass, mirrors, light bulbs, drinking glasses/mugs, oven/cooking glassware or pottery
- No pots, pans, coat hangers or paint cans
- No Styrofoam or plastic cutlery
- No medical waste such as syringes or needles
- No plastic grocery bags return to your grocery store for recycling
