TARC Routes Return to Regular Downtown Service

LOUISVILLE, KY. (November 18, 2020) — Effective Thursday, November 19, 2020, all TARC routes affected by the Downtown Detour (4th -7th Streets and Ali to Market Streets) will return to regular routing.

ALL STOPS which were closed as a result of the daily detour in downtown Louisville will be reopened; all associated route detours will be lifted, and downtown service will return to regular scheduled service.

It is important to note, TARC rides are still limited to essential trips only, and face coverings are required to ride.
