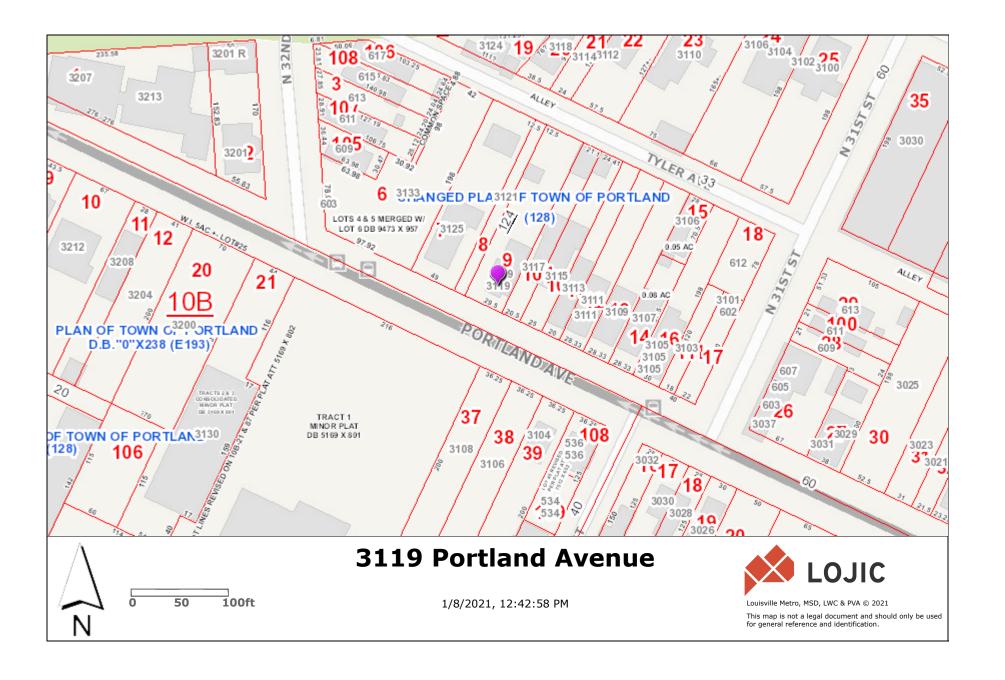

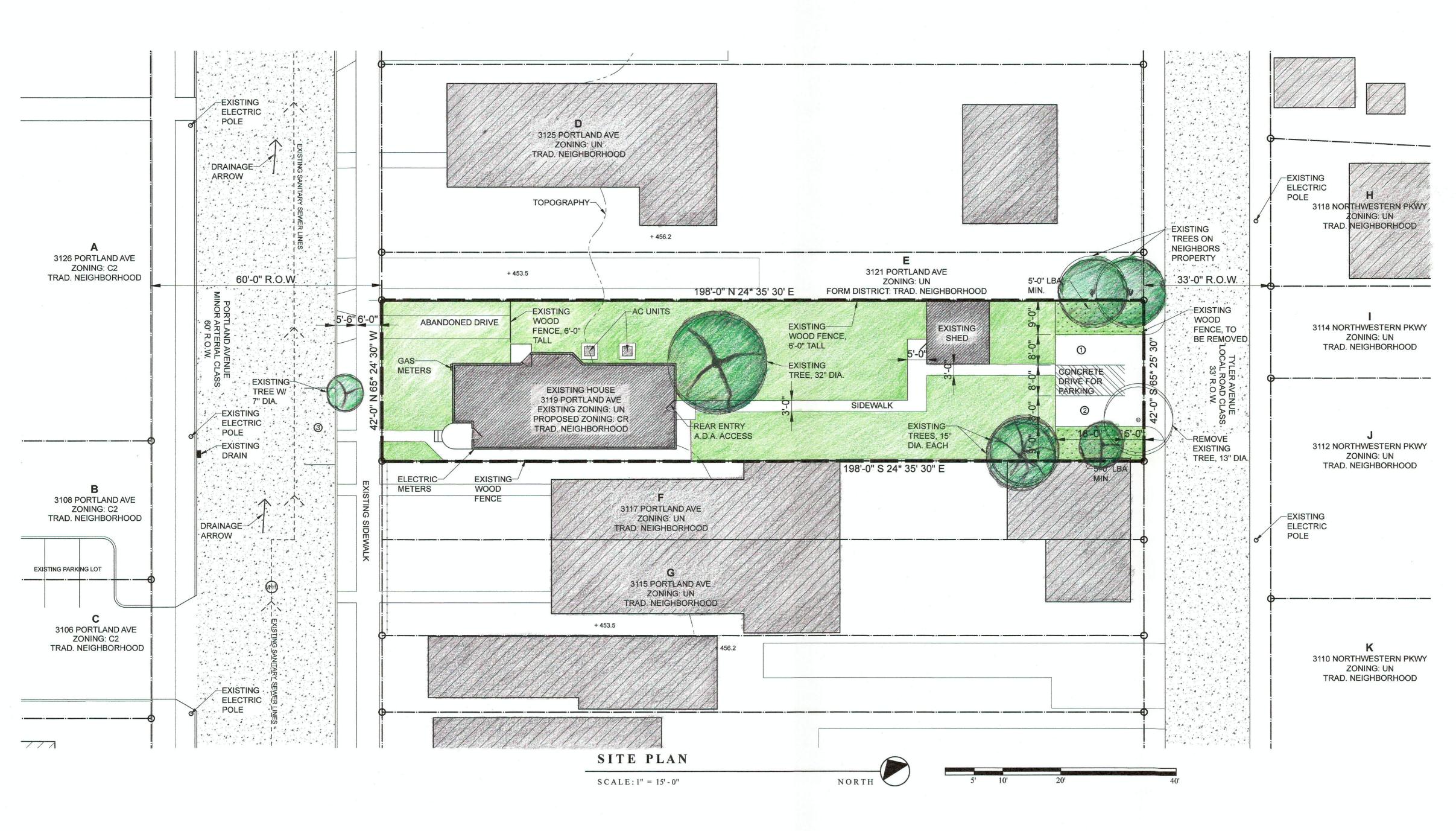

After the Neighborhood Meeting
