

2021 Property Assessment: How will it affect you?

The Jefferson County PVA is responsible for applying a fair and equitable assessment to residential and commercial properties as of January 1st each year. The PVA has a statutory responsibility to assess your property and you, as the property owner have a right to appeal. The notices will be mailed on April 23, 2021.

The Jefferson County PVA invites you to join one of our "You Have a Right to Appeal" virtual meetings in March and April to discuss the 2021 Property Reassessment and the appeal process for properties in your area. The appeals process will be open April 23rd at noon until May 17th at 4pm.

Homes and businesses in and around these neighborhoods will be reassessed in 2021:

Smoketown, Nulu, Butchertown, Shelby Park, The Highlands, Audubon Park, Crescent Hill, St. Matthews, Iroquois Park, Southside, Beechmont, Auburndale, Fairdale, Valley Station, Parkwood-Waverly, Hikes Point and Jeffersontown.
