## Kentucky Transportation Cabinet I-264 Improvement Project

## **Dear Valued Customer:**

Over the next few weeks, you may begin seeing LG&E crews and contract partners working in your area. We are starting the initial phase of relocating an existing natural gas line and related facilities from along U.S. 42 (Brownsboro Rd.) to a new crossing adjacent to Southview Drive, where the new crossing will tie into existing natural gas facilities. Weather permitting, we expect to have this work completed over the next several months.

This relocation work is being done in preparation for the upcoming Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KYTC) project to improve the interchange at I-264, also known as the Watterson Expressway. Our work will take place on KYTC's existing rights of way and along Merrifield Road.

In order to access the site, crews must enter and exit the area from Rudy Lane at Merrifield Road. We plan to complete this work in the most efficient manner possible and to minimize any inconvenience to you and others traveling through this area. This includes minimizing traffic disruptions between the hours of 9 a.m. and 3 p.m., Monday through Friday.

During this initial phase of the project, crews will relocate our facilities across I-264 and into the Merrified Road and Rudy Lane areas. After crews complete the work, areas where the ground has been disturbed will be covered and seeded with grass. Crews will return at a later date when temperatures warm up to work with customers along the project path to switch their natural gas service to the new line.



While customers' service will not be affected during this initial portion of the work, it's always important to remember if you ever think you may have an issue with your service or suspect a natural gas leak, leave the area immediately and then call us and 911. Our number one priority during any project is the safety of everyone in the area. We ask drivers to please be mindful of our crews' presence, and we appreciate everyone's patience while entering and exiting the neighborhood. We also ask that you keep children and pets away from the work site and any project equipment being used or stored in the area.
