In an effort to keep you informed about construction on the new Louisville Veterans Affairs Medical Center, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Louisville District is happy to share details on major activities planned for the coming week.

**Construction activities scheduled for the week of DECEMBER 27, 2021 include:**

- Earth work (weather dependent), to include some topsoil removal and minor grading is scheduled.
- A few pieces of additional construction equipment may also be delivered this week.

**Additional notes:**

In response to community members requests, the upcoming blasting times have been able to be rescheduled for 4-5 p.m., to better ensure school bus traffic is clear to help with previous concerns about possible traffic issues. Also, homeowners who had pre-blast surveys should be receiving their results via email soon.

The Department of Veterans Affairs and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Louisville District are building a new 104 bed, full-service hospital in Louisville, Kentucky to provide world-class healthcare to Veterans in Kentucky and Southern Indiana. The new 972,000 square foot facility will replace the existing Robley Rex VA Medical Center.
