This position is responsible for the organization, scheduling, and coordinating of community outreach events for the Social Justice Youth Development Certificate Program.

Executive Administrator - Community Youth Development | Click to apply

This position manages administrative support services including the budget, grants, personnel, strategic planning, and more while evaluating procedures and supervising subordinate personnel.

Policy Analyst - Community Youth Development | Click to apply

This position coordinates policy initiatives while collaborating with community partners on activities that support LMG's equity goals. Makes recommendations to community and staff based off analysis.

Pivot to Peace Project Manager | Click to apply

This position builds cross-sector capacity to implement community-based gun violence intervention strategies by overseeing, monitoring, and evaluating OSHN outreach and community partner work.

Grants Management Supervisor | Click to apply

This position supervises financial management of grant programs and activities by interpreting federal, state, and local regulations and exercising supervision over subordinate personnel.

Communications Coordinator | Click to apply

This position works closely with the Mayor's Communications Office to communicate with employees and the public about department strategies and composes publications about initiatives.

Social Services Program Supervisor | Click to apply

This position supervises, plans, and develops social service programs and advocates for the rights of clients while overseeing the development of departmental programs to meet community need.
