- What short & long-term interventions are important for the community?

Timeline & Schedule (May-Oct 2022)

There will be **8 workshops** spread across **6 months**. Workshops will be held **1-2 times a month** and require a total time commitment of **2-4 hours per month**. Workshops will be a mix of in-person and virtual gatherings. Exact dates will be determined by Community of Opportunity members' availability.
