July 5, 2023 10a.m. Press conference to launch “**Curbing Gun Violence in Jefferson County**” competition. It will take place at 43rd & W. Market St. This is the site where Christian Gwynn, age 19, was killed by a drive-by shooter December 19, 2019 at 9:30pm while walking home with a friend.

WHAT: Crescent Hill Community Council (CHCC) is sponsoring this competition. A \$1,000 prize will be awarded to the person submitting the best new idea, or a new twist on an old idea to curb gun violence in Jefferson County.

HOW: Each idea must be submitted in accordance to the “Rules for Submission” below, and accompanied **with the Official Submission Form** attached.
