1-3 lb. bag of onions
2 cans of cranberry sauce
3 to 5 cans of green vegetables
(green beans, peas, etc.)
3 to 5 cans of mixed vegetables
(corn, yams, etc.)
2 boxes mac-n-cheese
1 bag of flour and 1 bag of sugar
Dessert item such as cake mix/icing

\$25 gift certificate to buy meat/perishable items

A. 1 to 2 outfits per child
(Not to exceed two)

Example: 1 pair of pants
(jeans, etc. or skirt)
1 shirt or sweater
socks and undergarments
