LARGE HOUSEHOLD ITEMS

Furniture, mattresses, toilet, rolled carpet, etc. No loose garbage or construction debris.



ELECTRONICS

Limit 3; Go to Louisvilleky.gov/Electronics for a list of accepted items.



METAL & APPLIANCES

No refrigerators, freezers, dehumidifiers or other items containing Freon.



HOUSEHOLD RECYCLABLES

Paper, plastic, metal, glass containers.



PRESCRIPTION MEDICATION DISPOSAL



YARD WASTE

Less than 2 inch diameter and 4 feet long; bundled or in containers or paper bags. Wooden pallets also accepted. **NO PLASTIC BAGS**



ON-SITE PAPER SHREDDING

Containers must be taken back by resident.



PASSENGER TIRES

On or off rim. Limit 4



GENTLY USED SHOES

Donated to WaterStep.

NOT ACCEPTED

- Garbage or loose debris
- Concrete, bricks, rocks
- Construction materials (lumber, shingles, siding, etc.)
- Items containing Freon
- Paint
- Batteries
- Light bulbs
- Hazardous waste
- Boats or hot tubs
- Tree trunks
- Items from businesses
