Good morning Meagan,

I just wanted to follow up from our conversation yesterday. If the City's plans were to change and your leadership decided that they would like to continue with all the objectives and goals of your SWIFR grant we would need to hear from you by close of business **tomorrow Wednesday (25th)**.

At this point we would need a letter from your Mayor stating that the City of New Orleans intends to complete all the objectives of your SWIFR grant including the purchasing of the recycling carts. The letter would also need to state that your City Council will move forward with the contract to purchase the recycling carts from the the vendor you've selected. The Mayor would need to sign the letter herself with all these firm commitments if this were to even be considered at this point.

I also want to state, even with the signed letter form your Mayor, it still may not be possible to get an extension approved for your SWIFR grant. The deadline is coming so soon, and it might not be possible move things through our system that quickly.

We just want to be transparent about our process and realistic with the timeframe.
