

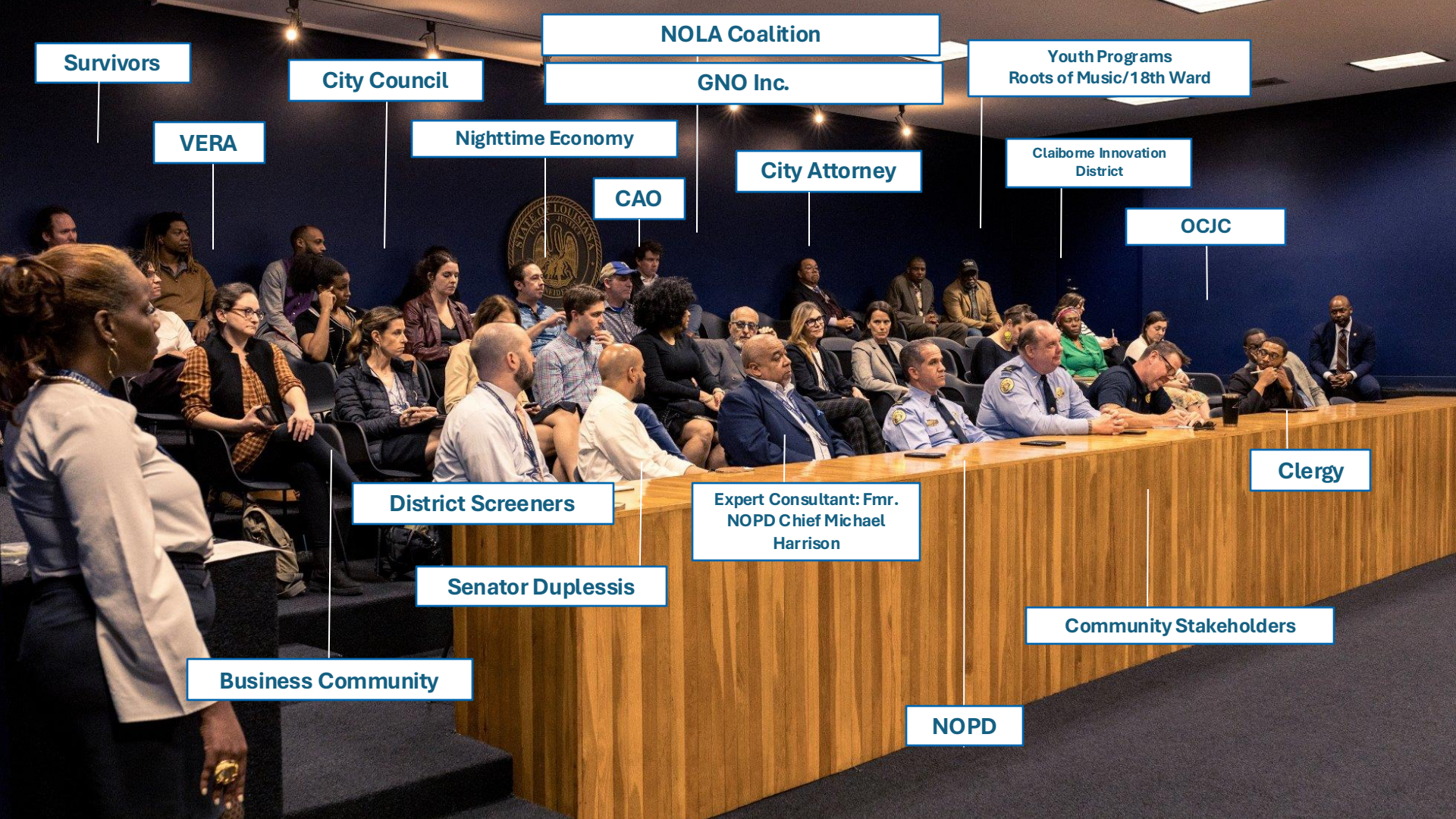

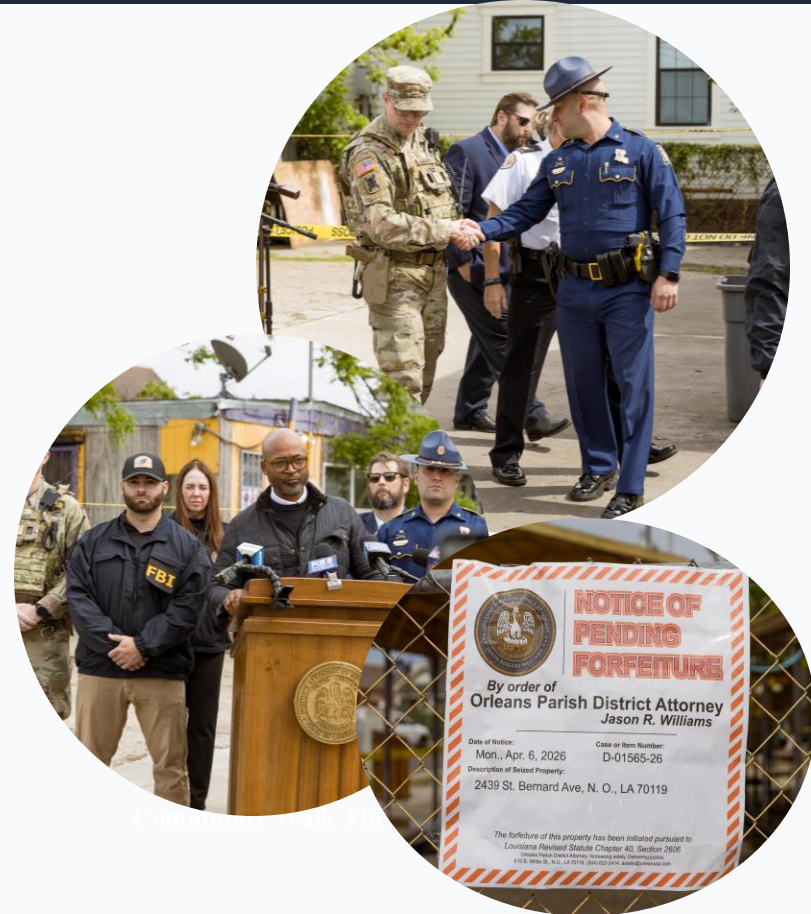

- Intelligence-led operations targeting violent offenders and organized crime

Neighborhood Selection

Communities of Hope Convening

- Strengthened partnership with faith leaders, neighborhood organizations, and city agencies
- Expanded community engagement to address public safety and quality-of-life concerns
- Continued collaboration with the Mayor's Office to support prevention-focused strategies



Joint OPDA/NOPD Recruit Training

- Mock Trial Exercise with NOPD Recruit Classes
- Courtroom testimony and witness preparation
- Building stronger courtroom presentations from day one



Collaborative Public Safety Efforts

- Multi-agency response to illegal tire dumping in New Orleans East
- Improving neighborhood quality of life
- Coordinated enforcement and prevention strategies

Operational Impacts

- Loss of ADA "warrant" funding
- Reduction in judgeships
- Continued focus on efficient case processing despite resource challenges

Homicide Unit

- 48 homicide cases brought to Grand Jury so far this year, returning indictments in 46 of those cases
- Continued collaboration with law enforcement to secure evidence-based prosecutions
