Sexual Treatment, Education, and Prevention Services (STEPS) is an outpatient program, offering therapy and psychiatric services for children and young adults ages 6 to 21 who are presenting with problematic sexual behaviors. This is a countywide program serving Medi-Cal eligible youth and focuses on maintaining the youth safely in the home, community, school, and increasing prosocial functioning. Services include individual, group, and family therapy, case management, as well as psychiatric services.
