TAKE ME HOME PROGRAM

PEACE OF MIND FOR FAMILIES



What Is the Take Me Home Program?

A free and confidential registry that helps law enforcement safely return individuals with special needs to their families if they become lost or disoriented. Deputies can access the system to find a match by photo and description and reunite families quickly.



Who Should Enroll?

Anyone in the San Diego community who may:

- Have difficulty communicating
- Be unable to identify themselves
- Become confused, disoriented, or lost

Ideal for:

- Individuals with autism or Down syndrome
- Seniors with Alzheimer's or dementia
- Anyone with a medical or cognitive condition



If a Loved One Goes Missing:

1. Call 9-1-1 immediately
2. Tell the dispatcher they are enrolled in Take Me Home
3. Provide important details (medications, fears, likely locations, etc.)

This helps deputies respond faster and more effectively to bring them home safely.
