Resources for Families to Receive Access to Healthy Food

CalFresh is California's Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program, or SNAP, and it is one of the most effective ways to ensure kids have access to healthy food. The benefit is uploaded to an Electronic Benefits Transfer (EBT) card that can be used to purchase food at places like grocery stores and farmers markets.

Additionally, having CalFresh provides eligibility for other food assistance programs, such as SUN Bucks (Summer EBT).

Schools and community organizations are trusted messengers and an important source of information for families. Please use this toolkit to help connect families in your community to the vital resources that CalFresh provides.

Why is CalFresh Outreach is Important for Students?

When kids are enrolled in CalFresh, they get the food they need to succeed both at home and school. But many newly eligible families may not know they qualify or how to sign up.

CalFresh helps kids at home:

Now is a great time to apply to CalFresh! A family of four can now receive up to **\$994** a month to purchase food.

*CalFresh benefit allotments amounts can vary on a month to month basis, based on income.

CalFresh helps kids at school:

Students enrolled in CalFresh are directly certified for free school meals and SUN Bucks (Summer EBT). Learn more about SUN Bucks in the next page.

Please Note: Immigrant families may be hesitant to enroll in CalFresh, but it is currently *safe for families to access*.

CalFresh helps kids in the classroom: When students consistently get the food they need, it leads to lower rates of chronic absenteeism, stronger test scores and fewer disruptions caused by behavior or trips to the nurse.

CalFresh Outreach is Important for Schools

CalFresh helps school nutrition budgets: Students enrolled in CalFresh are automatically certified for free school meals. That means fewer school meal applications to process and fewer unpaid meal charges.

CalFresh helps schools qualify for more programs: When more eligible students get enrolled in CalFresh, it improves a school's ability to operate free summer and afterschool meal programs and to adopt the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP), which enables eligible schools to serve meals to all students at no cost to families. In order to participate in CEP, schools must have Identified Student Percentage (ISP) over 25 percent, which includes students on CalFresh. Learn more about [CEP here](#).

CalFresh & Eligibility for SUN Bucks

What is SUN Bucks?

SUN Bucks, also known as Summer EBT (S-EBT), is a federal program that was established to help families buy food for their school-aged children during the summer.

Families will get **\$120 for each eligible child** (see eligibility chart on next page) to buy groceries during the summer. Families must use SUN Bucks within 122 days of funds being loaded to their card. Children who get SUN Bucks can still participate in other summer meal programs.

When kids are enrolled in CalFresh, they are **automatically certified** for SUN Bucks (also known as Summer EBT). This means there is no additional form or application for a parent to fill out for their child to access these food benefits.

Important SUN Bucks Facts

When families are automatically certified for SUN Bucks, the EBT card will be mailed automatically to their address on file with the county or the school. It is very important to remind families to **keep their mailing address up to date**, so that SUN Bucks benefits are sent to the right place!

- To update address with the county, families can do so online at BenefitsCal.com, calling the county at (866) 262-9887 or visiting your local county office.

If families have questions about eligibility or need assistance with obtaining or activating their SUN Bucks card, please contact the SUN Bucks Helpline at (877)328-9677.

For the helpline, families may follow the prompts as follows:

1. Language selection.
2. Card number (it will ask you for your card number twice - do not enter anything if you want to speak to a representative).
3. Select the number 5 and stay on the line to speak with a representative about SUN Bucks.

Agents are available to assist you from 6am to 8pm, Monday through Friday.

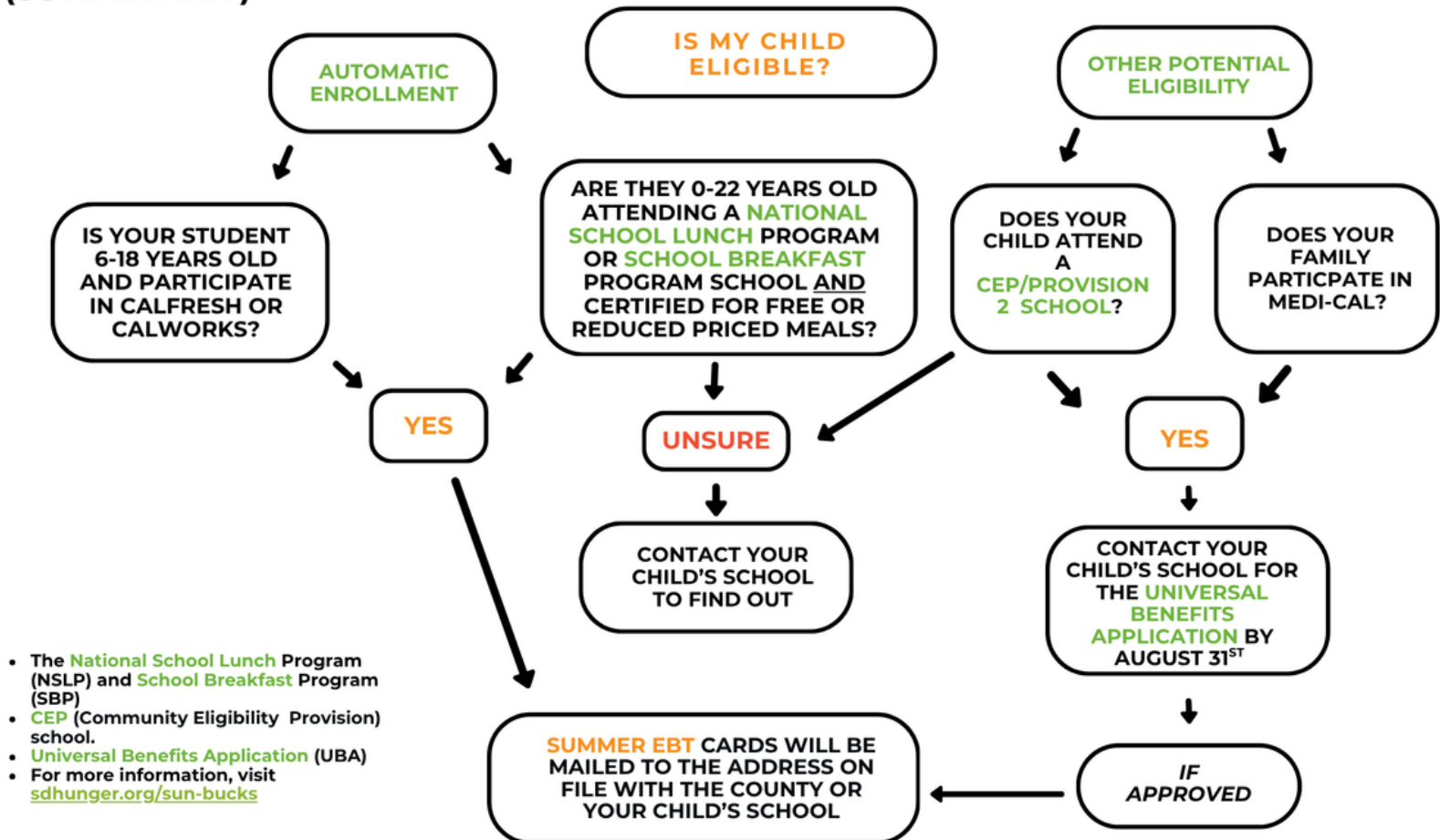

Increase Your Reach

Parents regularly look to schools as a trusted source of information. Help your families connect to CalFresh by adding a link to your district, school and nutrition department websites. CalFresh graphics and links are free to use and promote through your networks. No need to connect to Social Services for permission! Here is how to get started:

1. Contact your website administrators and ask them to add a link to BenefitsCal using the link benefitscal.com
2. Consider using language from our social media posts (page 9) or using our [sample social media posts](#) (page 16).
3. Add a colorful “button” to your website to use as a link to the CalFresh application page.



Senate Bill 708 (Mendoza, 2015) requires LEAs who have their meal application available online to include the CalFresh application link on their website.

Partnerships

Increase CalFresh Enrollment

Under Assembly Bill 402 Local Education Agencies (LEAs) can enter into Memorandums of Understanding (MOUs) with County Welfare Departments (CWDs) to share information regarding school lunch participants who may be eligible to receive CalFresh benefits.

With the permission of the parent or guardian signing some form of consent, information submitted on the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) application with the local county CalFresh office can be shared.

Goal of this program is to increase the number of eligible families receiving CalFresh by using information about students who are presently receiving free or reduced lunch.
